For over 100 years, Lake Shore Electric has strived to bring our customers quality equipment that exceeds the industry standard and utilizes the latest technology.

LSE standardized on a specific Baldor Motor configuration to operate the LSE transfer T-200, Style 1, Style 2, Style 3, FPL, MCDA, and MCSA transfer switches for over 30 years.

The Baldor company was sold in 2011, and the manufacturer obsoleted the model and series that Lake Shore Electric has used for multiple decades. Neither the manufacturer nor another vendor could provide a direct replacement. The legacy motor was designed out of the transfer switch offering in 2016.

We no longer offer a refurbishment program for the Baldor .44HP product offering; a direct replacement is unavailable.
